Natural or Man-made Disaster and Solidarity in EU Law

During the lectures, Prof. Teresa Russo will focus on the analysis of the principle of solidarity in the event of natural or man-made disaster in accordance with Article 222 TFEU, which can be considered the cornerstone of the co-operative system of the EU because of its cross-cutting and overarching character. The course will deal with the origin and scope of such solidarity with terminology, its implementation of the solidarity principle in the light of Decision 2014/415/EU and with the analysis of how the solidarity clause was supported case Anagnostakis in the Commission.

Teresa Russo is Aggregate Professor of International Organization at the Department of Legal Science (School of Law), University of Salerno since the year academic 2009/2010. Professor of the Ph.D. course in Legal Sciences, lasting three years, at the University of Salerno since 2013. She was visiting of Professor International Organizations at the University of Cadiz, she taught international organization and the EU law to the students of the Faculty of Law (2016).
