Environment protection and solidarity in EU Law

The main objective of the lectures will be to deepen the understanding of how solidarity is implemented in EU Law environmental field. The aim of this lecture will be question what are the solidarity duties that potentially derive from Art 37, Charter of Fundamental Rights which states that "high level of environmental protection and the improvement of the quality of the environment must be integrated into the policies of the Union and ensured in accordance with the principle of sustainable development". The course will deal with concrete examples of solidarity within existing European Union environmental and natural resources law and policy. The existence of a European ecological citizenship will be questioned and case law related to Solidarity will be of particular interest during class to examine the judicial treatment of ecological challenges. In this matter, the concept of solidarity will be particularly analyzed in the context of climate change law and climate justice.

Estelle Brosset is full Professor of Public Law at University Aix-Marseille III - Paul Cézanne. She is a specialist in European Union law and is in charge of teaching in this discipline. She co-directs the Master 2 in International and European Environmental Law. She was awarded a Jean Monnet by the European Commission (2012-2015) and is coordinator of the Jean Monnet Centre of Excellence at the University (2016-2019). devotes a large part of her research to the study of European law.
