Dear SoEULaw followers,

the first year of Jean Monnet Module “SoEULaw” came to an end. Despite the severe difficulties caused by the COVID-19 pandemic in Italy from March on, all the planned teaching activities and also some extra ones were offered to the Module participants. In particular, the students had the opportunity to attend 20 different courses led by several Professors, for a total of 79 lecturing hours.

Some of the abovementioned courses were delivered during the Winter School “Solidarity in EU law”, which took place in Pisa from Monday 3 to Thursday 6 February 2020 and was a great success, since we had the pleasure to host 38 participants from 4 different continents.

Moreover, many other activities were implemented during the year, such as the Roundtable Debate on Solidarity beyond Law; the Workshop on Solidarity in Case-Law, which took the form of a Moot Court Competition; and the Webinar “Respect for Fundamental Rights and the Western Balkans' Compliance to EU Standards”, organised in cooperation with the Jean Monnet Module “EUWEB – EU-Western Balkans” (University of Salerno, Department of Law).

Additionally, at the end of the year, the publication process of the ebook “New Awareness of Solidarity in EU Law and Beyond” begun. Such ebook will collect the best papers written so far by the participants to the Jean Monnet Module “Solidarity in EU Law”.

All the activities were promoted in order to reach a wide interest, attract different target groups and increase their knowledge in specific European Union studies related to Solidarity. The first year of the Module also increased the interest in Solidarity as a research field for the development of academic works and, thanks to the participation of leading professors from Europe and Latin America, it contributed to the creation of a European and international network on Solidarity.

We will continue updating you also during the second year of implementation of the Module, which will officially start on Tuesday 1 September 2020. You can follow all our activities in
